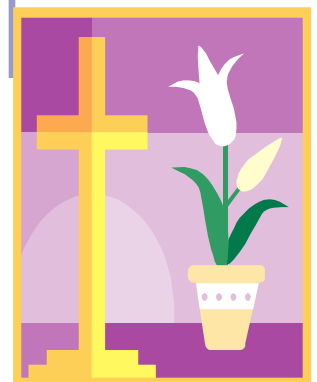


Spring Concert

about our school and our continued efforts for educational and spiritual excellence.

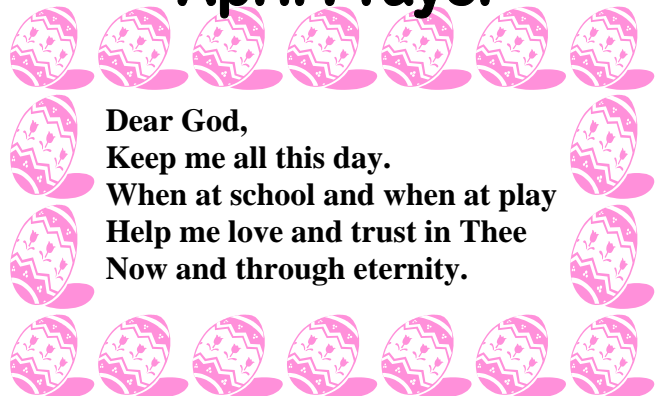
