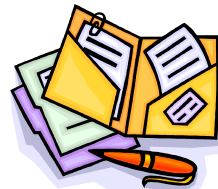
## Cold Weather

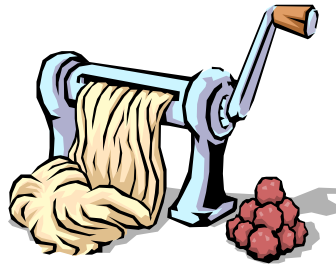

### Teacher Appreciation

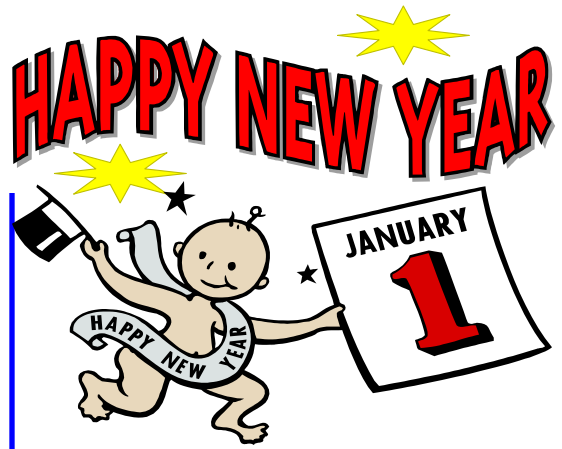
